WHAT TO DRINK

Galli Estate La Famiglia Pinot Grigio 2010 [Sunbury, Vic]
Has attractive caramelised stone-fruit aromatics but doesn't smell especially sweet. There's a sniff of Turkish delight also. Has chew, dried citrus peel, a flinty bite at the back, with mouth aromas of pistachio shell. This is a tasty little white to be served icy cold and ideally with a tuna, rocket, chilli and lemon linguine (so too the other wines reviewed here).
